Dismiss CA turf herbicide goes beyond sedge control to speed up and enhance postemergence control of goosegrass and over 45 broadleaf weeds when tank mixed with other postemergence herbicides, making it an even more valuable part of your total weed control program.



A Deeper Level of Control

Dismiss CA turf herbicide not only attacks weeds on the surface, it also penetrates the soil and works to control sedge tubers. This helps to prevent future outbreaks, reducing the need for re-treats down the line and minimizing chemical and labor costs for you.

In this study, soil from areas treated with a postemergence application of Dismiss herbicide were compared with untreated areas. As you can see, areas treated with Dismiss showed a clear reduction of sedge tubers.
