**DIRECTIONS FOR USE:** The application rates listed in the table will provide control of the pest under typical conditions.

Apply Talstar® Select Insecticide/Miticide as a surface or sub-surface treatment. Use application volumes of up to 10 gallons per 1000 square feet to get uniform coverage when treating dense and or long turf foliage.

For low volume applications, less than 2 gallons/1000 square feet, immediate irrigation of treated area with at least 0.25 inches of water following application to ensure efficacy against sub-surface pests is recommended.

Treatments can be made to control early to mid-season larvae (approximately August –

February) as they feed on plant crowns. Treatments made to late-season larvae (approximately March, April) may only provide suppression.

**RESTRICTIONS:** Do not water treated area to the point of run-off. Do not make applications during rain. Do not apply this product through any kind of irrigation system.
